About the Doyle Drive Replacement Project

The south access road to the Golden Gate Bridge, known as Doyle Drive or Route 101 in San Francisco, CA, is aging and must be replaced with a facility that meets modern seismic and design standards.

The Doyle Drive replacement is an approximately \$1.1 billion project that is set in a national park and will feature a parkway design including two short tunnels, a wide landscaped median, enhanced pedestrian access and traffic calming transitions.

Due to the commitment of regional leaders to cooperatively pursue federal stimulus money, the project has been divided into seven contracts, with two of these contracts expected to be advertised and awarded in summer 2009.
